National Research Lobachevsky State University of Nizhni Novgorod is a top Russian higher education centre providing thorough training in the best Russian academic traditions. The university has had the status of research centre since 2009.

Lobachevsky University's distinctive feature is high quality of education and affordable tuition fees. It offers a large range of education programmes and modes of study, as well as scholarships and grant programmes.

UNN won recognition worldwide. It is a member of the European University Association (EUA) and the Deans European Academic Network (DEAN) Executive Committee. It was listed in the top 100 BRICS education centres in QS Rankings 2013-2015.

In 2014, the University launched a state-of-the-art Lobachevsky computational cluster ranking 24th among the world's supercomputers. In 2015, it opened the SPF Vivarium , the third in Russia, to conduct research in schizophrenia, epilepsy, and Alzheimer's disease. In 2017, UNN launched the Center for Innovative Development of Medical Instrument Engineering featuring full design and marketing of competitive high-tech domestic products. The Centre is tasked with consolidating the research, clinical and education tracks.

## **International partnership**

Lobachevsky University cooperates with more than 100 education centres across the world and such global companies as Gazprom, Rosatom, Sberbank, National Instruments, Teleca, MERA, INTEL, MICROSOFT, HUAWEI, NVIDIA, CISCO SYSTEMS etc.

The programmes implemented with international partners include:

- Double degree programmes (University of Siena, University of Palermo (Italy), University of Grenoble Alpes, University of Rouen (France));
- Advanced training programme (University of Grenoble Alpes, France).

## **Preparatory department for foreign applicants**

### **Preparatory department for Bachelor's programme**

Lobachevsky University has a preparatory department for international students. Classes are held in groups in one of five fields (chosen by the student): Natural Sciences, Humanities, Economics, Engineering and Biomedicine. The basis of the training programme is intensive instruction in Russian as a foreign language (20 academic hours per week) and a number of specialised disciplines, which must be mastered for admission to the first year of the Bachelor's Degree Programme in the chosen subject area.

Content of the course (except for studies in Russian and Culture of Speech):

- Natural Sciences: Scientific Style of Speech (Natural Sciences), Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Computer Science or Biology (up to the student's choice);
- Humanities: Scientific Style of Speech (Humanities), Literature, Geography, History of Russia, Social Science;
- Economics: Scientific Style of Speech (Economic Sciences), Economics, Social Science, Mathematics, History of Russia;
- Engineering: Scientific Style of Speech (Engineering), Mathematics, Physics, Computer Science, Geography or Social Science;
- Biomedicine: Scientific Style of Speech (Biomedicine), Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology.

Duration of study:

- 2 terms (start – September 2017, end – June 2018).
- 3 terms (start – March 2018, end – June 2019).

### **Preparatory department for Master's programme**

Prior to enrolment in the Master's Degree Programme, international applicants may also take a course in the preparatory department. Classes are held in groups in one of five fields (chosen by the student): Natural Sciences, Humanities, Economics, Engineering and Biomedicine. The basis of the training programme is intensive instruction in Russian as a foreign language (20 academic hours per week) and a number of specialised disciplines, which must be mastered for subsequent completion of Master's Degree Programmes. During the course, students are given an opportunity to complete an interview in the teaching department and agree on a candidate for the student's research supervisor on the Master's Degree Programme.

Term of study:

- 2 terms (start – September 2017, end – June 2018).
- 3 terms (start – March 2018, end – June 2019).

### **Other types of training**

In addition to the main programmes, Lobachevsky University offers additional programmes for international students:

- International student mobility programmes;
- Russian as a foreign language courses (all levels);
- Russian for Specific Purposes (Political Science and International Relations, Philology, Economics);
- TORFL Preparation Programme (all levels);
- Russian Summer School;
- Research and teaching internship programmes for prospective international postgraduate students;
- One-on-one Russian language courses.

### **Support of foreign students**

The international students department provides support to applicants from their first application until the end of their studies. In particular, its employees oversee the admission and studies of international students, help with applying for a student visa to Russia, cooperate with other departments of the university, coordinate extracurricular activities, and provide support to graduates.

### **Everyday life of foreign students**

International students live in three dormitories on the university campus not far from the city centre. They are offered accommodation in triple rooms with furniture and bedding. Rooms are equipped with wired internet access points (on a paid basis). There are rooms for studying and free cloakrooms for belongings on each floor.

### **Leisure and sport events**

Every year international students take part in the scientific, cultural, sports and creative events of

university and at the municipal and regional level. They join in different kinds of sports, from football and swimming to karting and parachute jumping. All opportunities for creative self-actualisation are on offer at student competitions and festivals, social and cultural projects, and in student government.

- International Sport Festival (December);
- Spartakiad of Lobachevsky University (October-May);
- Student Spring Festival (March);
- Regional Academic Competition in Russian (April);

- International student open football tournament ISOFT-NN (May-June);
- International session of the regional youth camp Lazurny (July);
- International cultural and language club RKI+FIS (September - June);
- Gocce d`amore dance theatre (September - June).

### **Employment of foreign graduates**

Graduates of Lobachevsky University work at leading Russian and international companies (MERA, Intel, Sberbank of Russia, Rosatom), foreign financial organisations, as well as in diplomatic offices of foreign countries.
